

GUIDELINES FOR PAPERS FOR MATERIALS FORUM

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ABSTRACT

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- **a brief cv/biography and copyright transfer must accompany your manuscript (see last page).**

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1 MAJOR HEADING UPPERCASE, LEFT JUSTIFIED AND BOLD AND TWO POINTS LARGER THAN BODY TEXT

1.1 Intermediate Heading in Lower Case and Bold

1.1.1 Minor headings in plain lower case

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All figures and table should be numbered and each one must be located in the document, as close as practical after the first reference to it. All micrographs must be clear, black and white originals. (Originals will not be returned)

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References are to be made by sequential index number¹ with a listing in a final Reference section at the end of the text. The formats below should be followed carefully so that the paper is ready for republication.

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Authors: *Journal*, year, volume (number) pages.

Example:

R.A. Miller, P. Agarwal, and E.C. Duderstadt:
Ceram. Eng. Sci. Proc., 1984, vol. 5(78), pp
470-78.

References to *books* should include the edition, editor, and publisher.

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Examples:

J. Sickfeld: *Adhesion Aspects of Polymeric Coatings*, 5th ed., K.L. Mittal, ed., Plenum Press, New York, 1983, pp. 543-67.

Anon.: in *19th Annual Book of ASTM Standards*, Part 17, American Society for Testing and Materials, Philadelphia, PA, 1969, pp. 636-42.

A *private communication* or *company and agency reports* may be cited when required. The citation must include the affiliation and, where necessary, the address of the person involved as well as the year. *Papers presented at meetings but not published* are in this category. These must contain the Dissertation Abstracts number, if available.

Examples:

J. Smith, promotional literature titled "ABC Coatings - a New Technology," AAA Company, 123 Madison Ave., New York, NY 11733 (undated), 5 pp.

P.A. Siemers and W.B. Hillig, Thermal-Barrier-Coated Turbine Blade Study, NASA Cr-165351, Aug 1981, NASA-Lac, Cleveland, OH.

P. Ostojoc, The Adhesion of Thermally Sprayed Coatings, Ph.D. Thesis, Monash University, Dept. of Materials Engineering, Clayton, 3168, Australia, 1986.

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
