

Western Australia Speciality Alloys Site Visit

Western Australian Specialty Alloys (WASA) produces superalloy ingot, billet and bar for forging and ring rolling applications for a range of aerospace, power generation and oil & gas applications. Its melting facilities were commissioned late in 1993, and the nickel forging capabilities were added in 2013.

Due to U.S. Export Administration Regulations, the Names and Citizenship of all attendees is requested by WASA. This information will be used to conduct a Denied Party Screening check. Any visitors to plant that are citizens of a country identified in Country Group D:5 in Supplement 1 to Part 740 of Title 15, the U.S. Export Administration Regulations will need prior approval from our corporate legal team.

Please note that there is a cap for the tour of 18 people.

Remember to bring photo identification on the day of the visit so WASA can verify your identity before entering the facility. A driving license issued by an Australian state or territory or a passport would be suitable.

Please wear the following clothing and PPE that is required for the factory tour:

- High visibility clothing (WASA can provide vests if needed).
- Long sleeves.
- Safety shoes with an impact resistant toe.
- Hard hat (WASA can provide if required)
- Safety Glasses (WASA can provide if required)
- Hearing Protection (WASA can provide if required)

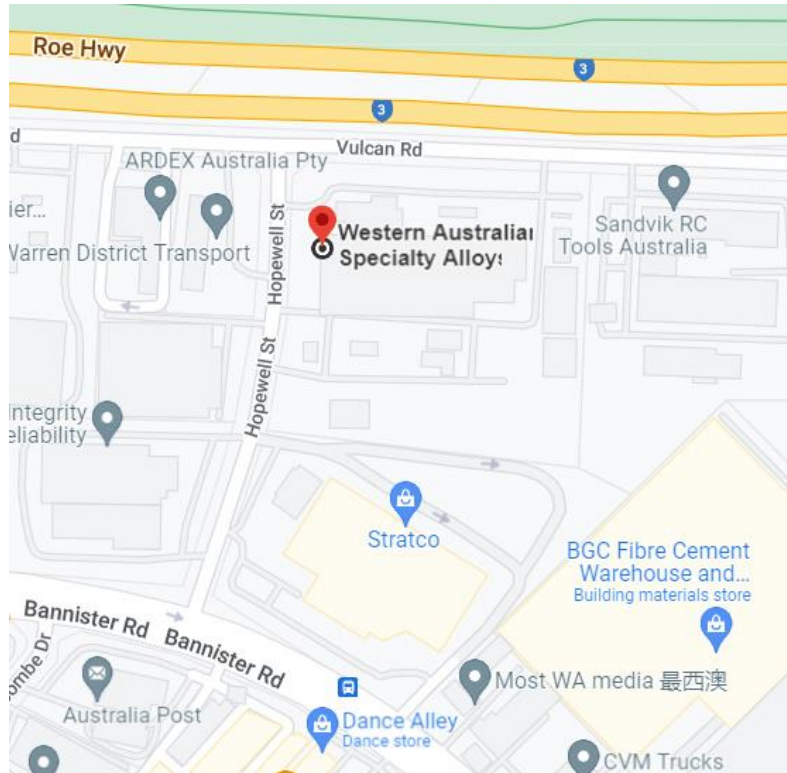
Given the current Covid situation we are requesting all attendees undertake a RAT in the afternoon prior to attending and provide confirmation of a negative result.
