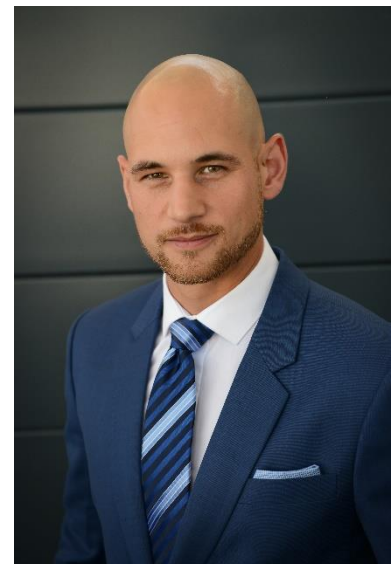
Steel Insulated panel construction has been used in five prominent Perth based projects – Perth Museum, Belmont Faulkner Civic Centre, Joondalup ECU Technical Sciences building, Karrinyup Shopping and the Next Data Centre.

This presentation will discuss the design approach for the projects and how Kingspan supplied the complete ‘through wall’ system, with the insulated panels acting as the structural substrate to the Aluminium façade systems used on the projects.

Alex Dennis is a highly motivated and successful Business Development Manager within the construction industry.

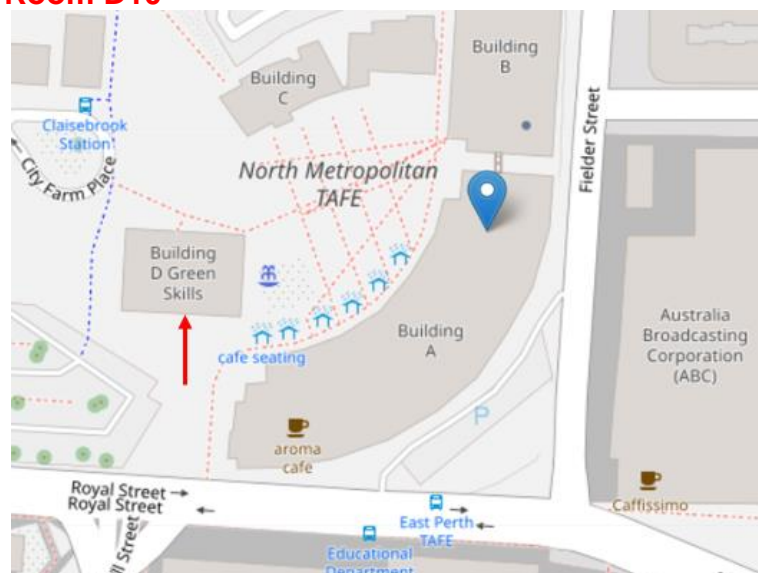
